
Lifelong Learner Activity Worksheet

Inquiry Question:

How much does a gallon of water weigh?


Materials:

- 1 gallon of water
- 1 gallon pitcher
- 112 inch ruler



1. Ask 7 people to guess what a gallon of water weighs. Record their guesses on the graph below. You might want to find the answer yourself first, so you can tell them after their guess.

- 2. Using a 12 inch ruler, ask them to estimate how many inches of water they normally use for their bath.
- 3. Get a gallon of water and time yourself carrying it around the room for a minute.
- 4. Next time you take a bath, use a gallon pitcher and measure ten gallons for your tub. Estimate how many inches it takes to fill it.
- 5. Estimate the number of gallons you usually use compared to the 10 gallons.
- 6. Ask yourself, if I had to carry every gallon of water I used, would I use less?
- 7. Record your insights and share with friends.
